How to get here

By Tube

- Nearest underground station is Rickmansworth. This is served by the Metropolitan line and is on Zone 7. Please make sure your ticket covers this zone or station. Oyster cards are accepted.

By Rail

- Rickmansworth Chiltern Rail also serves Rickmansworth and shares the same platforms as Rickmansworth Underground.

By Bus

- For Buses follow the Link below. There are also local bus stops on Rickmansworth High Street. If you need information, ask someone at the ticket office at Rickmansworth Station.

Walking from Rickmansworth Station (8 mins)

- Out of the station, turn right. Walk downhill with multi story car park on your left.
- Turn right and walk underneath the railway bridge.
- Continue walking straight down until you reach the main High Street.
- You should see NatWest Bank in front of you.
- Turn left and walk along the High Street until you see Café Nero on the left.
- There is a path directly opposite Café Nero between a Sandwich Bar and Riverside Pharmacy.
- Walk along the path and pass Ebury Road on the right. You are on Bury Lane.
- Continue walking straight until you get to Beeson's Yard on the right.
- There is an arch with the name Beeson's Yard on top.
- Walk into Beeson's Yard. Enterprise House is the first building. Report to the reception inside the first left entrance.
- AevaCare is on the first floor.

By Car (SatNav: WD3 1DS)

- Come off M25 Junction 18.
- Turn onto A412 heading towards Rickmansworth.
- Drive along A412 until you get to a roundabout.
- At the roundabout, take the first left and stay on the A412 until you get to a small roundabout.
- Turn right at the roundabout onto the High Street (this is a one-way street). Drive under the railway bridge.
- Pass the Pelican crossing. Continue on to the shops.
- Turn left at the traffic lights onto Church Street.
- Straight over the next traffic lights and take the first right onto Bury Lane (this is a one-way street).
- Drive down Bury Lane which lead onto a right turn.
- About 15 yards along there is a small entrance to Beeson's Yard on your left.
- You will notice an arch with the name Beeson's Yard on top.
- Drive down to the first building. This is Enterprise House.
- There are a few visitors' parking spaces in front of the building. Please do NOT park in any other spaces. If the visitors' spaces are full, then along Bury Lane outside Beeson's Yard, there are free parking spaces for one hour.
- Report to the reception inside the first left entrance on the ground floor of Enterprise House.
- AevaCare is on the first floor.

Parking

- There is ample parking around Rickmansworth. Most offer 2 hours free parking. The High Street is only free for 20 mins. Northway parking which is on two levels is 2 hours free parking and 5 minutes' walk to the office.
